**General Notification of Consent to Imports Pursuant to Article 3,
Paragraphs 6 and 7, of the Minamata Convention on Mercury, Setting Out
the Terms and Conditions under which the United States Provides its
Consent**

The United States hereby notifies the Secretariat that any Party that wishes to export mercury to the United States may rely on this general notification as the written consent required by paragraph 6 of Article 3. The U.S. government does not object to any import of mercury as defined in Article 3 provided that import conforms to requirements under the Toxic Substances Control Act, 15 U.S.C. § 2601, and other applicable law.
